**Parker Street Cinema** wield piano, bass, and drums (along with the occasional sample) to craft the kind of dynamic narratives Gershwin might have written if handed a distortion pedal or three. The kinetic trio craft compositions worthy of the most elaborate rock orchestras – music which articulates, emotes, and inspires a host of feelings both intimate and triumphant. This is the fabric of electric anthems.

Founded by bassist Kevin Dick and pianist Brian Glover, **Parker Street Cinema** fully formed once Ken Mahru joined after friend and original drummer Joe Sebok left to become a professional poker player. Carefully crafted over a number of months at Little Red Wagon Studios with labelmate Brad McGowan (Plot Against Rachel) and mastered by Silver Sonya's Chad Clark (Beauty Pill) and Devin Ocampo (Faraquet, Medications). **Abandoned Love Records** will release *Music, in the Blood* on December 4<sup>th</sup>, 2007, in time to make year-end accolade lists and in advance of the band's West Coast tour.
